### Who should apply?

Self employed people who must **submit proof** of being qualified in one or more of the following:

- 1) Fitting, Turning, Welding, Boilermaking, Rigging, Instrument Mechanician, Electrical Work, Chemical Operations or Chemical Manufacturing, AND/OR
- 2) Any other chemical related qualifications listed on the SAQA website for the glass sector, explosives, surface coatings, pharmaceuticals, etc (**please specify your area of expertise**)
- 3) Proven quality assurance experience of education and training.

### What documents must you attach to your CV and application?

- a) Submit certified copies of your technical qualifications for one or more of the qualifications listed in 1) or 2) above. Specify NQF Levels or equivalent.
- b) Submit certified copies of your education and training certificates incl assessor, moderator **registration** certificates, and technical trainer/facilitator certificates, and.
- c) Submit proof of your work experience, length of this experience, and the date of your **most** recent work in education and training environment (NQF and/or apprentice training), and also specify the roles you played.
- d) Submit a certified copy of proof of being a registered constituent assessor & moderator with the CHIETA (or another ETQA)
- e) Submit a certified copy of your valid driver's license. This appointment requires extensive travel. A car and a valid driver's license are needed.
